How did "Friends of Music Society" start, you ask?

I first got involved with this organization before it was founded as the "Friends of Music Society", in 1989. A year or so prior to us becoming a non-profit, I received a phone call from a stranger. It went something like this; "My name is John Farry. I work in Mental Health, and I would like to start a band featuring the talent of musicians suffering from mental illness. I heard that you play your accordion at Group Homes, and I'm hoping we could meet, and that you could give me some ideas." I was happy to do this, and after a couple of meetings, he wondered if I had a name for the band. I told him that I had a book on depression, entitled "Moodswing", and that since ballads in the 50's were called "Mood Music" and that the 40's was called the "Swing Era", the Band could be called "Moodswing". He loved the idea, and the rest is history. John's background in Mental Health had been in the upper echelon of the BC Government, where he was responsible for setting standards across the province, so his connections were invaluable. Being a multi-tasker he had time to envision what has become F.O.M. When I heard him make phone calls, he stated 3 things; 1) who he was, 2) what he wanted and, 3) how he could go about getting it. In other words, he moved fast. In the early days, the theatre where we meet, was mainly used for medical lectures. John invited me to bring my accordion. I would play "Beer Barrel Polka" and the "Tarantella . . ." The professionals around the building would peer in occasionally with smiles on their faces. John's first action plan was to hold a public forum at the Begbie Hall at R.J.H., inviting a prominent psychiatrist to speak. After the lecture, he pitched his idea for the Orchestra to upwards of 70 people. As momentum gathered, "Moodswing" was formed and our first public performance was at an event called "Tables of Eight", held at the UVic Faculty Club. John had Psychiatrists and other professionals sponsoring it, to pay for food, etc. The highlight for me in the early years, was a beautiful day at the Nanaimo Airport. Moodswing performed in front of a long retired B-17 airplane, that was on a North American tour. The Orchestra's music set the tone for the event. Being an avid aviation enthusiast, I was thrilled to meet some of the pilots who were decorated for their flying ability. When we got back to Victoria, we had a BBQ at the former Band leader's home. Other memorable occasions were our trip to Vancouver, staying at a Best Western Hotel, playing at BC Place, as well as the tea Dances at the Empress Hotel. Also there were several fun performances, at the then, Eaton's Center. Along the way John and I became great friends, until his passing, some years ago. I have watched the organization, grow into something we can all be proud of. I would like to thank everyone who has helped us, but most of all, I would have wanted to thank John Farry for believing in people, no matter what their challenges were, when he said, "I like to focus on what's right with people, rather than what's wrong with them."
